A Slew of Translation Activities

The book of Acts has received focused attention lately by the Irigwe translators. They translated it from Irigwe back into literal English in preparation for a consultant’s review, which has now taken place. Comprehension testing of the book continues.

The team is happy to report good progress on the daunting book of 1 Corinthians. Testing is currently underway. Also, Daniel and the team each did separate checks of the book and it was back-translated. Afterwards, the consultant reviewed it along with Colossians.

Daniel’s check of Ephesians has commenced, as planned. He’s up to chapter 3. Next will be the team’s check and back-translation of that book along with 2 Corinthians and Titus. Those three books are scheduled for a consultant’s review in March. Meanwhile, village testing of Romans has been completed and a second draft of Titus is in process.

Since former typist Ruth left for further studies, the project has been without a keyboardist. Pray that the team will get another person soon.

The “JESUS” Film—Dedication!

The dedication of the Irigwe “JESUS” film took place at year’s end. The state governor was guest speaker and the president of the Evangelical Church of West Africa was the dedicator.
